

Your Touch Knows! Science Experiment

Question: Can you use your sense of touch to identify objects?

My Guess: (What I think will happen?):

Materials: A pillow case, assorted toys, plastic objects, metal objects, soft objects, hard objects, etc. A paper to write or draw.

What I do: (Procedure): Use your sense of touch to identify objects.

1. Take turns doing this with several other people.
2. Place 5-6 objects of different kinds into a pillow case.
3. Have one person feel (without looking!) the objects in the case.
4. They must identify the object just with their touch and nothing else.
5. What happens?
