

Fun Facts: Constellations I



You can't see constellations during the day because the sun's light is too bright to see star light.

If you lived on the equator you can view all the constellations in a year.

If you lived on the North or South Pole, you will only be able to see the part of the sky above you.

The north star is in a fixed position above the horizon

There are 88 constellations in the sky

Most constellations can be seen from both northern and southern hemisphere depending on the time of year

Circumpolar stars mean they are visible year round
